

## Reflection Installation Tips

### *Get the application*

- Open a browser and type in:
- <ftp://techcoord@www.omeresa.net> (enter)
- Enter (FTP) username and password provided my OME-RESA staff
- Open (double-click) the Reflections folder
- Drag the reflection9.0(2).zip folder to your desktop

### *Install the application*

- Un-zip the Reflection program into a folder.
- Double-click the Install Icon in the Reflection folder.
- Choose Install Reflection for Unix and Open VMS
- Choose Workstation Install
- Wizard will open
- Follow the defaults, put a shortcut on the desktop

Note: If the end user plans to use a digital keyboard such as an **LK450** (or LK461) instead of a typical install, choose **Custom** install.

When selecting utilities, make sure you choose the LK450 keyboard utility and install it completely. This will enable you to add the keyboard mapping features later.

### *Set up the application*

- Open Reflection
- Choose Connection
- Connection Setup
- Choose Best Network
- Host type: 198.234.229.66
- Click Connect

Login using username and password provided by OME-RESA staff.

- Choose Setup
- Choose Terminal
- Choose keyboard tab
- Under Terminal keys, change VT backspace sends delete
- Click OK

*Save these settings*

- Choose File pull-down menu
- Choose Save As
- Click Shortcut button in bottom right corner
- Check mark Create a shortcut when saving files
- Select "On the Windows desktop"
- Click OK
